Vineyard

A single vineyard wine made from a 1.1 hectare vineyard planted in 1935 on a steep east facing slope of the ravine formed by the stream of San Ginés in Laguardia, Rioja Alavesa. We have named the vineyard "Barranco del San Ginés" referencing to the surrounding geography as the location of this vineyard. Planting density: 3906 Vines per hectare. Square planting pattern: 1,6m x 1,6m. Limestone soil. Altitude 526-546m. Massal selection. Old dry land bush vines.

Cellar

The grapes are sorted, destemmed and fermented in a small tank for 10-14 days with a gentle pump over once a day until the end of the fermentation. Once pressed the wine is aged in a 600 litre oak barrel for one year where this wine is naturally stabilized and clarified with time.

Tasting note

On the nose we have plum, blackberry, bramble, blackcurrant and pomegranate. It has a medium plus palate with texture and layers of complexity. A complex nose that benefits from a short decanting prior to serving.
