Production	3.333 bottles
Vineyard	This is our interpretation of the grape variety named Viura in Rioja, which is otherwise known as Macabeo in other parts of Spain. We aim to reflect the characteristics of the old clones of this grape variety from vineyards that are planted on the white limestone slopes of the Sierra Cantabria Mountain range in the north of Rioja Alavesa. We select the old low yielding dry land farmed bush vines for this wine.
Cellar	The grapes are whole bunch pressed. The must is cooled and settled naturally for 48 hours before racking the clean juice to large barrels where it ferments and ages on the gross lees for one year before bottling.
Tasting note	This wine has a lemon green colour with primary fruit aromas of elderflower, apple, lime, and peach. Some secondary aromas are present from the ageing on the lees. It has a medium palate, medium acid and medium alcohol with a long finish.
